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UK | 2017 PHEV MARKET BY MANUFACTURER AND MODEL

For PHEVs UK remains leading market in Western Europe


For plug-in hybrids (PHEVs), a growth sector long-dominated in Europe by Mitsubishi's Outlander PHEV, the UK remains West Europe's largest market. That's largely thanks to government car purchase grants plus notable benefit-in-kind (BIK) savings for company car users.

This first quarter, buoyed in no small measure by the UK's traditional March car sales bulge, the UK comfortably retained the lead as West Europe's biggest PHEV market. But the way things have unfolded of late, it looks as if the UK could soon be losing its European PHEV sales crown to Germany's currently heavily subsidised car market. In terms of PHEV sales, the gap between the UK and Germany at the first quarter point was just over 2,200 units.

In retrospect, last year, yet another good sales year for PHEVs in the UK, a continent-leading 31,286 PHEVs were newly registered in the UK's otherwise dwindling car market. Drawing attention to the on-going sales gains of both subsidised
